ERA to speed up flyover work

The J&K Economic Reconstruction Agency (ERA) will deploy additional labour and machinery to expedite the work on the 2.4-km Ram Bagh-Jehangir Chowk flyover, the construction of which had remained stalled last year due to unrest.

"The work on the flyover project is gaining pace rapidly. At present, the work is in full swing and in coming days additional skilled labour and machinery will be mobilised for the project. Till date, Rs 148 crore have been spent on the project," said Director, ERA, Kashmir, Satish Razdan.

Yesterday, J&K ERA Chief Executive Officer Vinod Sharma had conducted an extensive site visits of works being executed in

Srinagar city under its Jammu and Kashmir Urban Sector Development Investment Programme funded by Asian Development Bank.

The authorities had last extended the deadline of the flyover project to March 2017 in the wake of floods in 2014. However, the unrest has now further extended the completion to the end of this year as mobilising non-local labour workforce had remained an issue.

Sharma also visited a multi-level car parking facility being constructed by the Economic Reconstruction Agency. He was informed around 80 per cent progress had been achieved on the project. He also visited the Athawajan and Rawalpura areas where the construction of mega storm drainage projects is going on.
